

1. The Formulary is a list of drugs that are covered by the benefit. On our website you can find the Formulary for your plan; information on how to read a Formulary; and how to request coverage exceptions (prior authorizations).
2. Within GHCMYChart you will find information about our claims processing partner, Navitus. On the Navitus website you can locate participating pharmacies; drug information; and find out what your cost should be for specific drugs based on your benefit plan.
3. The Navitus Pharmacy Network includes most pharmacies in the United States. If your benefit plan has a deductible or coinsurance, be aware that prices may vary between pharmacies. That means your cost will also be different. If your plan has co-payments, your cost should be the same at any participating pharmacy, when your prescription costs are higher than the co-payment.
4. To assure your prescription benefit applies, always present your GHC-SCW ID card to a pharmacy before filling a prescription. (They may not need it if you are a repeat customer.)
5. Many (but not all) prescriptions are eligible to be filled in 90-day supplies; most (but not all) pharmacies are contracted to do this.
6. If you use a GHC-SCW pharmacy (in Dane County, Wisconsin), you can quickly order prescription refills via GHCMYChart.
7. Nationwide prescription mail service is available via our preferred Mail Pharmacy, NoviXus. This information can be found on the Pharmacy page located on the GHC-SCW website.
