GHC Foundations Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

GHC Foundations IOP is a treatment program for members who are either stepping down from higher levels of behavioral health care or could use more intensive services than outpatient therapy and medication management. The program is daily group psychotherapy, with individual therapy once a week, learning skills to enhance abilities to tolerate stress and regulate emotions. A virtual program is also available.

Your PCP or Behavioral Health Provider will write you a referral to participate.



Autism Services

The GHC-SCW Autism Spectrum Disorder Program offers neuroaffirming, inclusive and evidence-based services for children ages 4-16 diagnosed with ASD, along with their parents or caregivers. The program supports school-age children who struggle with friendships or emotional regulation. Depending on individual needs, services are available one-on-one, virtually, in the child's home (Dane County only), or in group settings at a GHC-SCW clinic. ASD Speech and Occupational Therapy services are also available.

Speak to your child's PCP to ask for a referral.
